Once again, ACLCA SA is putting the spotlight on the early professionals in our industry via the annual Early Professionals (EPs) forum. This is an opportunity whereby EPs from member companies can present a short seminar on a topic from the abstract options (attached) relevant to the site contamination industry.

### How do you get involved?

- If you are a site contamination consultant working at an ACLCA member company and have professional experience spanning 7 years or less, you are eligible and encouraged to enter.
- Prepare an abstract (in accordance with attached guidelines) for your proposed presentation and submit it via email to [sa@aclca.com.au](mailto:sa@aclca.com.au) – **Submissions close 5pm Friday 13 May**. Abstract topics are attached.
- Abstracts, which must be your own work, will be reviewed by a judging panel and three finalists will be selected to provide a face-to-face presentation on **Wednesday 1 June at 12:30pm**.
- Finalists will be notified by **COB Friday 20 May**.
- The judging panel will assess the presentations provided during the EP Forum and select the best presenter of the day – The judges' decision will be final!
- If you are a finalist, prepare your presentation– you'll have 25 minutes to present with + 5 minutes for Q&A.

### Prizes

- 1<sup>st</sup> prize – Full registration to attend Clean-Up Conference in Adelaide.

A live Q&A session will also be held where state winners can be involved together and there may be the opportunity if time permits to present again.

- 2nd prize - \$200 gift voucher
- 3rd prize - \$100 gift voucher
