

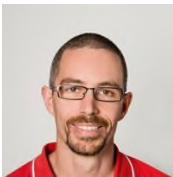
ACLCA-SA EARLY CAREER PROFESSIONAL (ECP) BREAKFAST PANEL PRESENTATION
