Join us for a snapshot of the Remediation of Chlorinated and Recalcitrant Compounds Conference.

Battelle's Chlorinated Conference is one of the world's largest and most comprehensive meetings on the application of innovative technologies and approaches for characterization, monitoring and management of chlorinated and complex sites.

### Presenters Bio:

- Dr Rai Kookana is a Senior Principal Research Scientist with CSIRO and an Honorary Professor with University of Adelaide. Since his PhD from the University of Western Australia (1989), he has been researching on environmental fate and effects of organic contaminant in the environment. Dr Kookana's current research interests include environmental fate and ecological risks of emerging contaminants (e.g. PFAS, pharmaceuticals and personal care products, nanoparticles and nanopesticides) in the aquatic and terrestrial environments. He has published >200 journal papers, with an H-Index (ISI) of 44 and a total citation > 7000. He is also on the editorial boards of 4 international journals and has served as Science Fellow of the Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA). In 2012, Dr Kookana was elected Fellow of the Soil Science Society of America. In 2016, he was awarded the prestigious Prescott Medal by the Australian Society of Soil Science.
- **Steven Kirsanovs** (Director, Kirsa Environmental Consulting) has over twenty years of consulting experience. He holds a Bachelor of Civil Engineering degree from the University of Melbourne in addition to a Masters of Engineering Science (Groundwater Studies) from the University of New South Wales. His core areas of expertise are in civil engineering, geotechnical engineering and groundwater contamination issues. Steve is an accredited contaminated sites auditor in Victoria, Western Australia and South Australia.
