Synopsis:

This presentation will provide an overview of the key issues and risks related to the presence of lead in soil. This includes discussion of the different sources of lead contamination, the potential for exposure, how we assess risks to human health and the relevance and importance of blood lead data.

The presentation will outline how lead has been addressed in the NEPM and the use of bioaccessibility analysis for site-specific assessments.

Presenter's Bio:

Dr Jackie Wright is the Director of Environmental Risk Sciences and a Fellow of the Australasian College of Toxicology and Risk Assessment. She has over 25 years' experience in human health and environmental risk assessment and toxicology, covering a wide range of contaminants and exposure issues. She has been directly involved in the development of national guidance on the assessment of contaminated land and clandestine drug laboratories.
