Alex’s experience related to groundwater contamination studies includes investigations/assessments, hydrogeological conceptualisation, predictive analytical/numerical fate and transport modelling, nature and extents analysis, natural biodegradation and natural attenuation monitoring (MNA), risk assessments as well as groundwater exploration, dewatering and management of groundwater resources.
