Once again, ACLCA SA is putting the spotlight on the young professionals in our industry via the annual Young Professionals forum. This is an opportunity whereby YPs from member companies have the opportunity to present a short seminar on a topic from the abstract options (overleaf) relevant to the site contamination industry.

How do you get involved?

- If you are a site contamination consultant working at an ACLCA member company and have professional experience spanning 7 years or less, you are eligible and encouraged to enter.
- Prepare an abstract (≤250 words) for your proposed presentation and submit it via email to sa@aclca.com.au – **Submissions close 5pm Friday 26 June**. Abstract topics are overleaf.
- Abstracts, which must be your own work, will be reviewed by a judging panel and three finalists will be selected to provide an online presentation (via Zoom) late July. Finalists will be notified by COB 30 June.
- The judging panel will assess the presentations provided during the online YP Forum and select the best presenter of the day – The judges' decision will be final.
- If you are a finalist, prepare your presentation for the online YP Forum – you'll have 15 minutes to present + 5 minutes for Q&A.

Prizes

- 1st prize – Full registration to attend EcoForum virtual conference. ALGA will produce a professional video for circulation prior to all delegates along with the other state winners. A live Q&A session will also be held where state winners can be involved together and there may be the opportunity if time permits to present again.
- 2nd prize - \$200 gift voucher
- 3rd prize - \$100 gift voucher
