Synopsis:

Moving from investigation to remediation generally requires collection of additional and in some cases different information to facilitate remediation planning and depending on the degree of cost and time certainty desired. The nature and extent of additional information will be discussed and illustrated using examples from the remediation of a number of major Australian ex-situ remediation projects undertaken over the last 20 years including chemical sites, gasworks and landfills.

Presenter's Bio:

John Hunt is a geologist by training who had worked in the contaminated site investigation and remediation industry for three decades. He had been involved in the planning and execution of many iconic remediation projects and spoken regularly at conferences on lessons learned from these projects. He is a senior technical adviser in Ventia's remediation group. He will be joined in the Q and A session by Matt Clutterham who is also a senior technical adviser and works alongside John.
